The International Monetary Fund (IMF) is an organization of 187 countries, working to foster global monetary cooperation, secure financial stability, facilitate international trade, promote high employment and sustainable economic growth, and reduce poverty around the world.



Tonny Lybek, a Danish citizen, is the IMF's representative in Romania and Bulgaria since March 31, 2009. He joined the IMF in 1992, where he has worked on a broad range of issues, among others, monetary policy, banking supervision, payment systems, central bank legislation and published papers on central bank governance. In the IMF, he has worked in the Fiscal Affairs Department (1992-93), European II Department (1993-94), Monetary and Capital Markets Department (MCM: 1994-2007), and European Department (2007-). During his previous assignments, he has worked on countries in the region (e.g., Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Albania). As Mission Chief in MCM, he worked on Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kazakhstan, and the Kyrgyz Republic. In 1986, he graduated from Århus University in Denmark. After teaching for a year, he worked in the Danish Central Bank (Danmarks Nationalbank) for five years, mainly on international reserve management and monetary policy.

Eureko Romania is a company active in three business lines: private pensions, life insurance and health insurance, for the latter being the market leader. The main shareholder is Achmea BV one of the largest and strongest Dutch insurance companies.



Radu Craciun, is a Romanian citizen, holding the position of Deputy General manager and Chief Investment Officer for Eureko Pensions where he works since 2007. He has more than 80m euros assets under management. Previously he has worked for 10 years in ABN AMRO Romania where he held different financial markets related positions and ending as the Chief Economist of the bank. He is as well a board member of the Private Pensions Association, Heading the Investment Committee, as well as a founding member of the Romanian Financial Analysts Association. In addition to the above, Radu is the president of the Cliniclowns foundation in Romania, a charity targeting hospitalized children. Radu has a constant presence in the local written and broadcast financial media.
